

## **FAQs**

**Here you can find answers to commonly asked questions regarding attending our Movie in The Park events.**

### **How much is admission?**

All Movies in the Park are FREE to our community and guests.

### **Your schedule says that movies start at “dusk”. What time is dusk?**

Dusk is approximately 15 minutes after sunset. We cannot specify the exact time each movie will start because sunset times vary through the season and also on-site conditions may change which could alter the start time somewhat. ### **So what time should I arrive?**

Come early and enjoy our beautiful park! Take advantage of pre-movie activities that are taking place before the movie begins. Check each schedule listing for an overview of what's happening!

### **Is smoking allowed?**

All movie events are smoke-free. This includes tobacco, e-cigarettes and vaporizing products. Thank you for your cooperation. Smoking is permitted outside of the park and we ask that you please place your cigarette butts and trash in the provided trash receptacles.

### **What should I bring?**

Plan to bring a chair or blanket for your comfort. Chairs are not provided at any of our events. Our location will have food available at our concessions area. We accept all major credit/debit cards for your convenience. You may want to bring a sweater or light jacket - it will cool down once the sun sets.

### **What can I not bring?**

We do not allow coolers, alcohol of any type or concealed weapons or skateboards.

### **Where can I park?**

We have ample free parking in and around town and there are several handicap spots available in the bank parking lot.

### **What if it rains?**

In the event of rain or high winds a movie may be cancelled. If it rains on the day of the movie you're planning to attend, please contact the park office to hear up-to-date information on possible cancellations or check our Facebook page.
